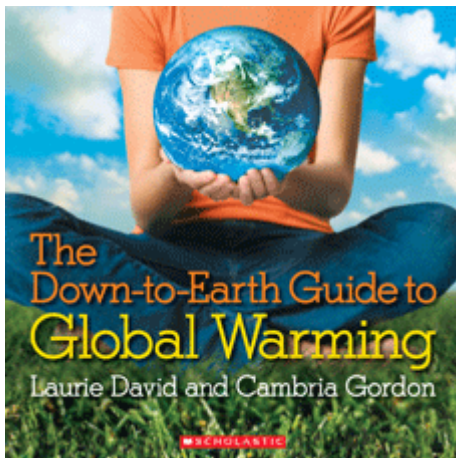

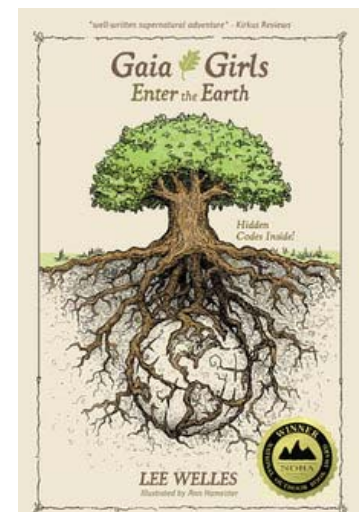

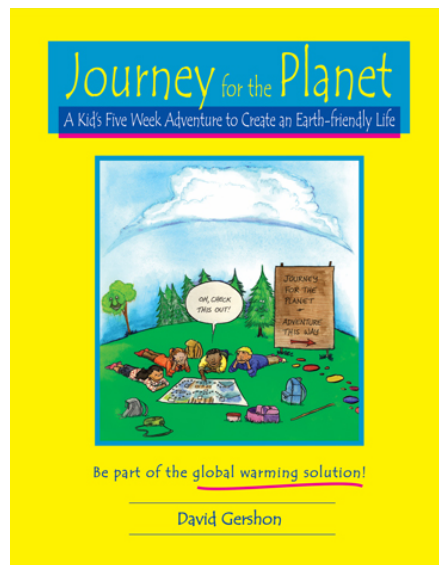
This very-readable guide will help you understand why global warming happens, how it affects the planet, and the simple steps we can all take to get involved in protecting the environment.
