"The Natural Step (TNS) is a framework grounded in natural science that serves as a guide for businesses, communities, educators, governmental entities, and individuals on the path toward sustainable development." www.ortns.org

The Natural Step has four system conditions to be applied to decision-making, which are restated here for the sake of brevity:

1. Limit the use of fossil fuels and metals.
2. Eliminate bio-accumulative toxins (PBTs).
3. Preserve and restore natural systems.
4. Empower people and communities.
